## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

### Tournament Date

- **10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> March 2018** (Saturday - Tuesday)  
10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> March - 2 sessions  
12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> March - 1 session evenings only

### Tournament Venue

### Categories

- Women's Open - **16 draw only** (National Closed satellite – PSA players will be accorded PSA points)  
- **Singaporeans only**
- Women's Division 1 (C Grade & below) – Singaporeans and Permanent Residents (PRs)
- Women's Division 2 (E Grade & below) – Singaporeans and PRs
  
- Men's Open - **16 draw only** (National Closed satellite – PSA players will be accorded PSA points)  
- **Singaporeans only**
- Men's Division 1 (B Grade & below) – Singaporeans and PRs
- Men's Division 2 (D Grade & below) – Singaporeans and PRs
- Men's Division 3 (F Grade and below) – Singaporeans and PRs
- Men's Masters 1 (Age 35 years & above) – Singaporeans and PRs
- Men's Masters 2 (Age 45 years & above) – Singaporeans and PRs
- Men's Masters 3 (Age 55 years & above) – Singaporeans and PRs

\* Each player may enter only one event

### Age Cut-off Date

- **10<sup>th</sup> March** 2018 for respective age group

### Entry Registration, Eligibility & Closing Date

- It is open to **Singaporeans** and **Permanent Residents** of Singapore only.
- Please provide your correct date of birth. We will verify them with your passport/identity card.
- **Late entries** will not be accepted.
- Entries must be received with payment via online entry form **before 18<sup>th</sup> February 2018.**

### Entry Fee payment

- \$50 Entry fee
- Payment shall be made together with the entry submission via SportyHQ
  - Only credit card facility is available.

### Entry Submission & Withdrawal

- All entries **MUST** be submitted via the online entry form:

- Withdrawal from Championship must be accompanied with valid reasons. Entry fees **will not** be refunded if withdrawal is done after closing date.
- The tournament requires a full commitment of a player to complete all of his/her matches. Players who are uncertain of their schedule are encouraged not to sign up to avoid any disruptions to the fixtures.

### Categories, Seeding, Scoring & Format, Rules and Regulations

- A category must have a minimum of 8 players to be opened. In the event the minimum number of players is not met; the organizer may exercise the option to combine with a higher category.
- Seeding brackets will be followed as per the table below:

Seeding brackets	Type
1 <sup>st</sup> – 2 <sup>nd</sup>	Placed in the respective starting position.
3 <sup>rd</sup> - 4 <sup>th</sup>	Random seeding. I.e. Both 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> seed will be subjected to the luck of the draw.
5 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup>	Random seeding. I.e. 5 <sup>th</sup> to 8 <sup>th</sup> seeds will be subjected to the luck of the draw.
9 <sup>th</sup> – 16 <sup>th</sup>	Random seeding. I.e. 9 <sup>th</sup> to 16 <sup>th</sup> seeds will be subjected to the luck of the draw.
17 <sup>th</sup> onwards	Random seeding. I.e. 17 <sup>th</sup> seed and below will be subjected to the luck of the draw.

- All main round matches will be played to best of 5 games. All others matches can be subjected to a best of 3 games format if deemed necessary.
- Scoring - 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally) following the WSF Rules of World Singles Game
- Knockout Format will be used for all categories. All players will be guaranteed 2 matches.
- Register 30 minutes before scheduled match time. Match timing is an indication only. Matches will be played on a **FOLLOW-ON-BASIS**. Postponement of match will not be entertained.
- Players will be required to referee matches. Failure to do so can result in a ban (1 year from all SSRA organized/supported events).
- Walkover will be awarded against players who do not show up upon being called to play; subsequent matches will be forfeited and subjected to a ban (1 year from all SSRA organized/supported events) unless a valid MC is produced and prior notice to organizer is given.
- Players will be expected to play more than 1 match a day.
- All Under 19 years of age players are required to wear protective eyewear during play.
- All players shall not hold Singapore Squash (SG Squash) or any Match, Tournament Officials responsible for any loss, damage or injury, therefore arising from and during the competition.
- SG Squash reserves the right to make any changes to the Rules and Regulations without prior notice during the competition. All decisions made by the Tournament Director will be final.
